ORDER

Appellant filed an appeal from a common pleas order involving clearing title on real property. Appellant moved for the appointment of counsel. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion. *See* Rule 608(g), SCACR (providing that counsel should not be appointed for an indigent unless the indigent has a right to appointed counsel under the state or federal constitution, a statute, a court rule, or the case law of this state); *Ex parte Dibble*, 279 S.C. 592, 310 S.E.2d 440 (Ct. App. 1983) (holding there is no constitutional right to counsel in civil cases).
