The State with the Supreme Court on June 5, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Samir Kevin Shank v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 21, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and the Appendix in the case of The State v. Ronald Lee Lyons with Supreme Court on May 13, 2026. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Rehearing in the case of Maurice Anthony Odom v. The State with this Court on May 12, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Adrian V. Simmons v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 6, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Ryan Oneal Gist with this Court on May 6, 2026.

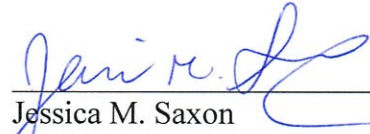

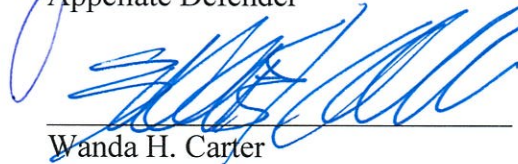

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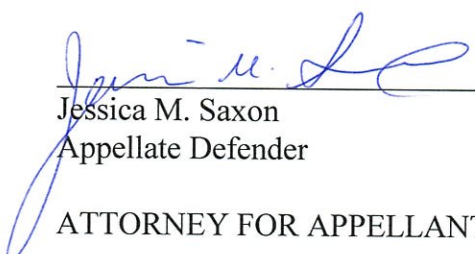
