Dear Clerk,

I respectfully submit this notice to inform the Court of significant developments that have occurred while my appeal remains pending in the Southland property case involving the McClary family.

Today, the water service to my residence was disconnected by the water utility. Before the disconnection, I informed the utility personnel that my case is currently pending before the South Carolina Court of Appeals and explained that there is an ongoing dispute concerning my tenancy and related issues. Despite my explanation, the water service was disconnected.

This follows an earlier incident in which a representative from Vesco came to the property and turned the water off. After learning that the water utility had disconnected the service, a Vesco employee later restored the water and advised me that if the utility disconnected it again, I should turn it back on from the outside. I have not relied on that advice and am instead bringing these events to the Court's attention.

After today's disconnection, I contacted the water utility and was informed that I would have to pay \$220.00 to have the water service restored.

I respectfully provide this information so that the Court is aware of developments affecting my family and the property while this appeal is pending. I am preserving all available documentation, including utility bills, receipts, correspondence, and photographs, for the record.

I respectfully request that this notice be placed in the case file and considered as part of the procedural history of this matter. If additional filings or documentation are required, I will promptly provide them.

These actions have resulted in continued disruption of essential water service to my residence while my appeal is pending. I am documenting all communications and preserving all relevant records, including receipts, lease agreements, and correspondence.
