Upon reviewing your attempt to correct the deficiencies outlined in this Court's letters dated June 23, 2026, regarding your notice of appeal *and* motion to stay, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed and the Court will not consider your motion to stay:

- The required filing fee has not been submitted. **The correct notice of appeal filing fee is \$250.00.** See Rules 203, SCACR.
- The accompanying proofs of service are not in compliance with the SCACR. Specifically, pursuant to Rule 262(c)(3), SCACR, and *Re: Methods of Electronic Filing & Service Under Rule 262 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules*, S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated May 6, 2022, only lawyers admitted to practice in South Carolina may serve other lawyers using the lawyer's primary email address in AIS. You must serve Respondent's counsel by US mail or hand-delivery.
- You must sign the notice of appeal *and* the proofs of service as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.

- Proof of filing with the clerk of the lower court has not been provided pursuant to Rule 203(d), SCACR. You must provide proof of having filed the notice of appeal with the clerk of the lower court.
