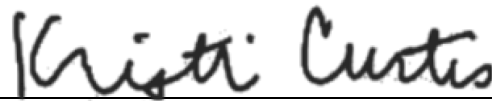

ORDER

On April 28, 2026, we dismissed this appeal because Appellant failed to provide a sufficient guilty plea explanation as required by Rule 203 (d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR and Appellant's counsel failed to forward her guilty plea explanation to Appellant along with a statement that Appellant had twenty days to inform this Court in writing of any arguable basis that there are issues preserved for appeal. Appellant's counsel filed a motion to reinstate, and we reinstated the appeal on May 19, 2026.

Appellant's counsel forwarded her guilty plea explanation to Appellant, and Appellant filed a guilty plea explanation with this Court on June 10, 2026. Appellant's explanation does not present an arguable basis that there are issues preserved for appeal as required by Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed, and the remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
