ORDER

On February 27, 2026, we dismissed this appeal because Appellant failed to provide a sufficient guilty plea explanation as required by Rule 203 (d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR. Appellant's counsel filed a motion to reinstate, and we reinstated the appeal on March 31, 2026, to provide Appellant with the opportunity to provide this Court with an arguable basis that there are issues preserved for appeal.

Appellant's counsel forwarded his guilty plea explanation to Appellant, and Appellant filed a guilty plea explanation with this Court on June 11, 2026. Appellant's explanation does not present an arguable basis that there are issues preserved for appeal as required by Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed, and the remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
