number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

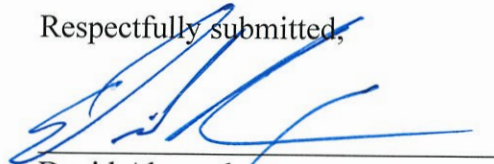

The State with the Supreme Court on June 15, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Marty Brown with the Court of Appeals on June 12, 2026. Counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Kereen Donyell Lee in the Court of Appeals on June 9, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of James Bubba Patterson v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 8, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Daniel Machito Buckson with the Court of Appeals on June 3, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of The State v. Desmond Lamar Green with the Supreme Court on June 1, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Joseph Landry with the Court of Appeals on May 22, 2026.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

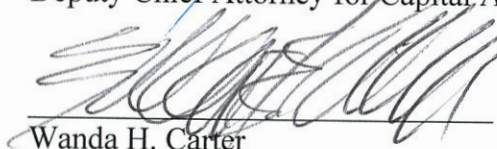

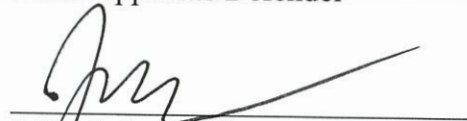
