**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR APPELLANT

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, Appellant, Marvis Williams, moves for an extension of time in which to order the transcript. Appellant requests a thirty (30) day extension to order the necessary transcript, which is due on July 2, 2026. This is the first request for extension filed by Appellant, Marvis Williams.

The grounds for this motion is that Appellant is currently incarcerated within the South Carolina Department of Corrections and intends to seek assistance from the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense for purposes of obtaining the transcript necessary for this appeal. Before counsel may submit the required materials to the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense, counsel must first receive Appellant's executed Affidavit of Indigency.

Appellant is currently incarcerated, and as a result, counsel has not yet received the executed Affidavit of Indigency despite diligent efforts to obtain it. The affidavit has been forwarded to Appellant for execution, and counsel anticipates submitting the necessary materials to the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense promptly upon its receipt. Receipt of the executed Affidavit of Indigency is required before counsel may seek funding for the transcript through the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense. Accordingly, counsel has been unable to order the transcript, thereby necessitating this request for additional time to do so. Upon receipt of the executed Affidavit of Indigency, counsel will promptly submit the required materials to the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense and thereafter order the transcript.

This Motion is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay and a thirty (30) day delay would not prejudice the rights of any of the parties. Accordingly, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court grant an extension of thirty (30) days, or such other period as the Court deems appropriate, within which to Order the necessary transcript. This motion has been served upon all parties as referenced by the Certificate of Service herein attached. Granting this motion would

extend the due date to Order the transit to August 2, 2026.

For the reason stated above, appellant respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension to order the Transcript until August 2, 2026.
