ORDER

On April 8, 2026, this court granted Respondents-Appellants Heather and Gabriel Crespo's motion to take judicial notice of certain exhibits and ordered the exhibits filed in a supplemental record on appeal; however, the order explained, "[T]his order merely allows the court to review the exhibits during its consideration of the appeal; any impact this ruling may have on the appeal will be considered in

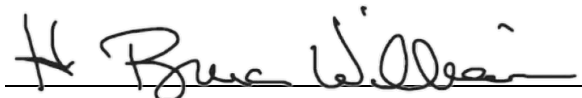
conjunction with the court's further consideration of the appeal."

On May 12, 2026, Respondents-Appellants Heather and Gabriel Crespo moved to dismiss Appellants/Respondents appeal of the civil judgments for common law invasion of privacy, explaining that the impact of the exhibits permitted to be filed in the supplemental record on appeal necessitated this result.

Appellants/Respondents filed a return, opposing the motion.

Respondents-Appellants Heather and Gabriel Crespo filed a reply.

After careful consideration, we deny the motion to dismiss without prejudice to this court considering any impact the April 8, 2026 ruling may have on the appeal in conjunction with the court's further consideration of the appeal.
