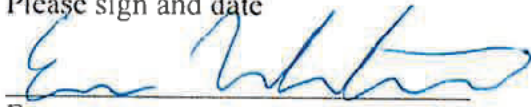

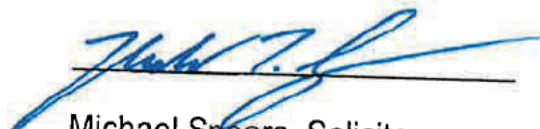

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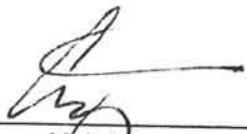

Criminal Conspiracy

That in Dorchester County, South Carolina, on or about January 31, 2022, the Defendant, Joshua Bryan Jordan, did combine, conspire, confederate, agree or have tacit understanding with persons known and unknown, for the purpose of accomplishing an unlawful object or lawful object by unlawful means, to wit: in late 2021 into the early months of 2022, including January 31, 2022, the defendant sought to introduce contraband into an SCDC facility and in furtherance thereof, sought to intimidate SCDC officers by means of arson, all in violation of Section 16-17-410, et al. of the Codes of Law of South Carolina.
