COME NOW Appellants, Saint Matthews Healthcare, LLC; Melissa Kizer; and Melissa Davis, by and through their undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and move for an extension of fifteen (15) days' additional time to file/serve a petition for rehearing of this matter, which the Court decided via opinion filed June 3, 2026. *See Vaughn v. Saint Matthews Healthcare, LLC*, Unpublished Op. No. 2026-UP-260.

Presently, by order of this court filed June 18, 2026, the deadline to petition for rehearing is July 6, 2026. Because of work-related and other time commitments, the undersigned counsel for Appellants requests the Court's allowance of fifteen (15) days' additional time to petition for rehearing.

Respectfully, the undersigned submits there is good cause for the Court to grant the relief requested herein, as it is, under the circumstances, a reasonable dispensation, timely sought, consistent with the interests of justice, posing no threat of undue prejudice to any other party.
