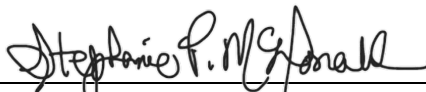

ORDER

On March 11, 2026, Respondent filed a motion to require Appellant to file a corrected record on appeal because the record on appeal "fail[ed] to contain all matter designated by Respondent." On April 23, 2026, this court ordered Appellant to serve and file an amended record on appeal "that includes all the documents designated by each party in the respective designations of matter to be included in the record on appeal." On June 1, 2026, Appellant filed a "motion to take judicial notice and request for extension of time." In his motion, Appellant expressed difficulty in obtaining the designated items and requested more time to serve and file the record on appeal.

After careful consideration, we grant Appellant's request for an extension of time to serve and file the record on appeal. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Respondent shall provide Appellant with all documents designated by Respondent. Within sixty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of this appeal.
