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Ms. Harrison:

I respectfully write regarding the Court's assessment of a second filing fee in connection with what has been treated as a second appeal in Appellate Case Number 2025-001651. I request that the Court review the file and reconsider the requirement of an additional \$250 filing fee.

The additional Notice of Appeal was necessitated by the Court of Appeals' decision to allow the Hill Family Trust of Arizona 2008 to proceed with additional hearings out of the ordinary course of process. This filing is not a separate or independent appeal, but rather a continuation of the existing appeal encompassing the additional proceedings granted to the Trust.

I further note that I, along with my law firm—which is not a party to this litigation—have been evicted from my office. My law firm was not a party to the eviction at any point in the proceedings. As a result of this wrongful eviction case files, law firm documents, equipment, other business assets and items necessary to conduct business are held hostage by the Hill Family Trust of Arizona of 2008, Charleston County Magistrate Sheryl Perry, Charleston County Constable Joe Doe 1 and 2, and Charleston County Sheriff's Department. Bubba Hill a presumptive trust beneficiary (he is at all the hearings but not one had seen the alleged TRUST) has placed 5-8 do not trespass signs around my business and they changed the locks on the doors to my law firm. This situation caused by the wrongful eviction and the holding hostage of the business assets has severely disrupted the law firms business, my ability to practice law, earn income, and has placed my business in jeopardy.

The above described actions of the Trust and their legal system is in direct violation of the South Carolina Supreme Court's order in this case.

The purpose of this correspondence is to respectfully request that the Court reconsider the imposition of a second filing fee. I do not have the financial resources necessary to pay this fee at this time. Should the Court determine that a second filing fee is required, I respectfully request leave to proceed in forma pauperis.
