Dear Ms. Sabb and Clerk of Court Office,

I am writing to formally document that I still have not received a clear written status update regarding the court filing I first addressed with your office on May 5, 2026.

On May 5, I was informed that the original mailing had not been received and that Allendale County is an e-filing county. I responded in writing that I would proceed through the e-filing process and requested confirmation once my submission was received and docketed.

Several months have now passed, and I still have not received a clear written response identifying:

1. Whether my filing was received;
2. Whether it was accepted, rejected, returned, or remains pending;

Dear Clerk of Court and County Administration,

I am writing to formally document and escalate an issue regarding a time-sensitive court filing sent to your office.

My Summons and Complaint were mailed on April 24, 2026 to 292 Barnwell Highway, Allendale, SC 29810, with an estimated delivery date of April 27, 2026. As of today (May 5, 2026), I have been informed that these documents have not been received or logged.

Given standard USPS delivery timelines, the mailing should have been delivered and processed. The lack of confirmation raises serious concern regarding possible administrative delay, misrouting, or intake processing failure within the office.

This delay is materially impacting my ability to proceed in a time-sensitive legal matter.

Accordingly, I am requesting the following actions:

1. A complete internal review of all incoming mail received between April 27, 2026 and present, including items pending intake or not yet logged;
2. Confirmation of whether my filing is in your possession but not yet processed;
3. Immediate date-stamping and docketing of the filing upon identification;
4. Written confirmation of the results of your review.

Please be advised that I am simultaneously preparing a re-submission via certified mail with tracking to ensure proper documentation of delivery. However, I request that your office make every effort to locate and process the original submission to avoid duplication.

If this matter cannot be resolved promptly, I will be compelled to pursue further escalation through appropriate administrative and judicial oversight channels to ensure proper handling of court filings.

I expect a written response confirming the status of this matter.
