CLERK: Your Honor, and then the 2025-GS-3204573, the State of South Carolina versus Robert Tyrwick Hoffman. Indicted charge for possession with intent to distribute methamphetamine. Pleading to possession methamphetamine - first offense. Waiving presence of the Grand Jury.

Indictment 2025-GS3204571, the State of South Carolina versus Robert Hoffman. Indicted on charges for domestic violence in the second degree. Pleading to domestic violence in the third degree. [Inaudible -- muffled/muted].

DEFENDANT SWORN IN

CLERK: Will you please raise your right hand? Do you solemnly swear or affirm the testimony you give the Court today to be the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, so help you God?

MR. HOFFMAN: Yes, Ma'am.

CLERK: Thank you.

THE COURT: Good afternoon, Mr. Hoffman.

MR. HOFFMAN: Afternoon.

COURT COLLOQUY WITH DEFENDANT

THE COURT: You've heard the charges as read into your hearing by our clerk - possession of methamphetamine, first and domestic violence in the

1 third degree. How do you plead to those two charges,
2 sir?

3 MR. HOFFMAN: I am guilty, Sir.

4 THE COURT: Alright. Sir, did anyone threaten
5 you, force you, or promise you anything in exchange
6 for pleading guilty to these two charges?

7 MR. HOFFMAN: No, Sir.

8 THE COURT: You do realize that by pleading
9 guilty to this charge you give up the right to have a
10 jury trial in both instances and in the possession of
11 methamphetamine, you give up the right to have this
12 indictment reviewed by a grand jury.

13 MR. HOFFMAN: Yes, Sir.

14 THE COURT: Do you still wish to plead guilty?

15 MR. HOFFMAN: Yes, Sir.

16 THE COURT: Are you satisfied with the
17 services rendered by your attorney?

18 MR. HOFFMAN: Yes, Sir.

19 THE COURT: Has she answered all of your
20 questions and done everything you've asked of her?

21 MR. HOFFMAN: Yes, Sir.

22 THE COURT: It's my understanding that this
23 plea of guilty that you've just entered on both charges
24 is without recommendations, which means I, as the
25 Judge, decide the sentence that you get. If you're

1 dissatisfied with my sentence in any way, shape, or
2 form, you have the right to appeal such, but you must
3 do so within ten days, in writing, to this Court. Do
4 you understand that?

5 MR. HOFFMAN: Yes, Sir.

6 THE COURT: Alright. Please listen carefully
7 to what the State has to say.

PLAINTIFF ADDRESSES THE COURT

9 MS. TAYLOR: Thank you, Your Honor. On
10 February 16th of 2025, there was an incident between
11 the defendant and his cohabitating girlfriend, Jessica
12 Ellison. They had been dating for about a 0about a
13 year, and again, they had left -- lived together.

14 At the 1200 to 2700 block of Old Charleston Road,
15 in the [Inaudible -- muffled/muted] area of Lexington
16 County. They got into a verbal altercation that
17 escalated when he put his hands on her neck and tried
18 to choke her. She did have pain in her throat and was
19 unable to breathe, as she reported to law enforcement.

20 We have complied with the Victim's Rights Act in
21 that case. The victim, we were -- we attempted to
22 call her for today's plea, the number was not in ser-
23 vice, however, she has previously reached out to our
24 office and said that she wants the charges dropped and
25 wants to be -- to get back together with him.

1 A few months later, on August 28th of this year,
2 there was a traffic stop here in Lexington County near
3 Meadowfield Road and Blackville Road in the Gashton
4 area. There, during a probable -- probable cause
5 search of the vehicle, it revealed a 1.7 gram clear
6 rock like substance in a plastic baggie that was lo-
7 cated in the driver's side front compartment near the
8 gear shift and the defendant was the driver of that
9 vehicle.

10 Your Honor, his prior record consists of 2004 -
11 conspiracy; 2007 - conspiracy and a possession with
12 intent to distribute schedule I drugs; 2010 - conspir-
13 acy and driving under suspension; 2011 - distribution
14 of meth first; 2014 - simple possession of marijuana,
15 reckless driving and a failure to stop for a blue
16 light; 2015 - accessory after-the-fact of a felony;
17 2017 - driving under suspension second; 2018 - assault
18 and battery third; 2019 - possession of less than a
19 gram of meth and another failure to stop for a blue
20 light; 2020 - DUS third and HTO; and a 2021 DUS first.

21 And there is a -- an HTO charge that is being
22 dismissed in consideration of the plea to these charges
23 today.

24 THE COURT: Alright. Thank you. And I see
25 that there is a Order --

DEFENSE ADDRESSES THE COURT

1 MS. TAYLOR: Yes, Your Honor.

2 THE COURT: -- firearms prohibition, which I
3 have signed.

4 Sir, you've heard the facts and allegations as
5 outlined by the State. Do you still wish to plead
6 guilty?

7 MR. HOFFMAN: Yes, Sir.

8 THE COURT: I'll accept your plea of guilty as
9 being freely and voluntarily given with the advice of
10 competent counsel with whom you are very well pleased.
11 [Inaudible -- muffled/muted], ma'am, I'll hear from
12 you.

13 DEFENSE ADDRESSES THE COURT

14 MS. CONROY: Thank you, Your Honor. May it
15 please the Court. Respectfully, Your Honor, I would
16 ask you to consider a probationary sentence in this
17 case. He does take accountability to these charges,
18 but with respect to the domestic violence third degree
19 that he's pleading to, it's our position that this is
20 a toxic relationship between him and the victim in
21 this case.

22 It's my understanding that although the victim in
23 this case wants to continue with the relationship, it's
24 Mr. Hoffman's position that he does not intend to
25 continue a relationship with the victim in this case.

1 They have no children in common. They have no reason
2 to ever speak again in the future as far as he is
3 concerned.

4 His hope is that he can get back to work. He
5 does reside in Lexington County, he works in Lexington
6 County. His job is at an auto mechanic shop and he
7 can go back there upon his release. He's been in the
8 jail now for about two months. I believe he has credit
9 for about nine weeks, if I'm not mistaken, total, Your
10 Honor. We would ask you to consider a probationary
11 sentence in this case.

12 MR. HOFFMAN: And I completed the LRADAC as
13 well.

14 MS. CONROY: That -- that's right, [Inaudible
15 -- muffled/muted] Your Honor, he did complete the --
16 the -- excuse me, the LRADAC program since he's been
17 in the jail. He wanted me to make you aware of that.
18 Thank you.

19 THE COURT: So, it's about, if my mathematics
20 are somewhat correct, about sixty-three days?

21 MS. CONROY: Yes, Your Honor.

22 **COURT IMPOSES SENTENCE**

23 THE COURT: With regard to Case Number 2025-
24 GS-3204571, this is the case of Robert Hoffman. This
25 is the charge of domestic violence third degree. It

COURT IMPOSES SENTENCE

1 is hereby the sentence of this Court that Mr. Hoffman
2 is sentenced to sixty-three days in jail, which is
3 time served.

4 With respect to Case ending in number 04573 -
5 possession of methamphetamine. First, it is hereby
6 the sentence of this Court that Mr. Hoffman is given
7 sixty-three days of credit with regard to his sentence
8 of twenty-four months. And that concludes this matter.

9 MS. TAYLOR: Thank you, Your Honor.

10 MS. CONROY: Thanks Your Honor.

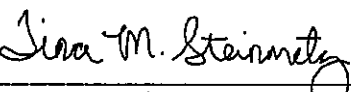

Per the Defendant, Robert T. Hoffman's request, defense counsel respectfully submits this Motion to Reconsider the sentence imposed by the Honorable Judge Vernon Dunbar on October 30, 2025. Defense counsel is not seeking a hearing on this motion, and instead, submits its request for consideration by way of written motion only.

BACKGROUND

The Defendant was arrested on or about August 29, 2025 and charged with Distribution of meth, 1st offense. He pled guilty to Possession of meth, 1st offense on October 30, 2025 and a sentence of twenty-four (24) months was imposed. The charge resulted from a traffic stop in Lexington County where the Defendant was stopped for a traffic violation, and officers determined that the Defendant was driving under Habitual Traffic Offender status. The Defendant was arrested and upon an inventory search of the vehicle, a substance believed to be methamphetamine was found in the vehicle. The Defendant was additionally charged with being a Habitual Traffic Offender, but that particular charge was dismissed as a part of plea negotiations. At the time of this plea, the Defendant also pled guilty to Domestic Violence, 3rd Degree stemming from an unrelated arrest which occurred prior to the Defendant receiving the Distribution of Meth and Habitual Traffic Offender charges. The Defendant received a time-

served sentence on the Domestic Violence, 3rd Degree charge.

ANALYSIS

As defense counsel mentioned during the plea hearing, the Defendant takes full accountability for being in possession of methamphetamine at the time of his arrest. However, there are certain mitigating factors that Mr. Hoffman would respectfully ask the Court to consider in hopes of having his sentence of twenty-four months reconsidered which was not mentioned by defense counsel during the hearing.

The defendant is a father and responsible for the welfare of his children. As a result of his incarceration, he has lost both his home and employment. He has no other family members to help take over his finances on his behalf. The Defendant is hoping to be able to find a job as soon as possible so that he can earn money for housing for his family.

For these reasons, the Defendant respectfully requests that this Court reconsider its sentence on its order imposed on October 30, 2025.
