Transcript of the Circuit Court Hearing — Timely Response to the Court's Letter Dated July 2, 2026

Dear Madam Clerk:

I write in response to the Court's letter dated July 2, 2026, which states that this appeal will be allowed to proceed and directs me to provide, within ten (10) days, proof of having ordered the transcript of the hearing before the circuit court. This letter and its exhibits are submitted within that ten-day period.

Transcript Order. On July 9, 2026, in compliance with the Court's July 2, 2026 letter and Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR, I ordered the transcript of the March 3, 2026 motion hearing before the Honorable Daniel D. Hall (York County Court of Common Pleas, Courtroom F, Moss Justice Center; lower court Case No. 2025CP4604727) in two parallel ways: by a written order emailed to the Court Reporter Section (transcripts@sccourts.org), with a copy to the Clerk of this Court, and by a submission through the official South Carolina Judicial Branch Transcript Request Portal. Court Administration confirmed receipt of the Portal order the same day under Transcript Request ID 1134525367, stating that a transcriptionist will communicate an estimated cost of production within five (5) business days. The written confirmation from Court Administration and the email order are attached as Exhibit A. I note that the official case record in the Portal identifies Ebony Love-Taylor, DCRP, as the digital court reporter assigned to the March 3, 2026 hearing.

Prior Initiation of the Request Process. The transcript request process was in fact first initiated on March 4, 2026 — the day after the hearing — through the same Portal, to which the Court Reporter Section itself directed me. The Portal's verification email issued that day at 11:59 a.m. is included in Exhibit B and confirms my entry into the official transcript request system at that time. To date, no transcript has been produced, and no invoice, cost estimate, or further instruction has been received from any court reporter. My repeated written requests and the responses received are attached as Exhibit B, and copies of this correspondence are furnished to all parties and to the Clerk in accordance with Rule 207, SCACR.

Chronology of Efforts to Obtain the Record. The following sequence, documented in Exhibit B, shows a consistent and continuing effort — not a single abandoned inquiry — to obtain the official record needed for this appeal:

1. March 4, 2026, 11:40 a.m. — First written request to the Court Reporter Section for the record of the March 3, 2026 hearing.
2. March 4, 2026, 11:46 a.m. — The Court Reporter Section refers Appellant to the official Transcript Request Portal.
3. March 4, 2026, 11:59 a.m. — The Transcript Portal issues Appellant an email verification code, confirming that Appellant entered the official request system that same day.
4. March 4, 2026, 12:13 p.m. — Renewed written request citing Rule 607(i), SCACR, regarding retention of primary and backup recordings.
5. March 17, 2026 — Formal Second Request seeking written confirmation whether the hearing was recorded, identification of the custodian of any recording, and the specific legal basis for any refusal.
6. March 17, 2026 — The Court Reporter Section replies by restating only the release prohibition under Rule 607, SCACR, without answering those questions.
7. July 9, 2026 — Transcript ordered by email to the Court Reporter Section (copy to the Clerk of this Court) and through the Transcript Request Portal; Court Administration confirmed receipt under Transcript Request ID 1134525367 (Exhibit A).
8. This letter and its exhibits are submitted to the Court within the ten-day period set by the July 2, 2026 letter.

Unresolved Status of the Record. Despite repeated requests, I have never received a definitive answer whether the March 3, 2026 hearing was recorded. The Court Reporter Section stated only that, other than ordering an official written transcript, court rules do not allow the release of the audio or video of any proceeding “regardless of the manner of capture” (Rule 607, SCACR) — language that addresses release, not existence. On March 17, 2026, I formally requested written confirmation whether a recording exists, identification of its custodian, and the specific legal basis for withholding it; no definitive written response addressing those questions has been produced. Separately, on March 12, 2026, staff of the York County Clerk of Court's office told me that Common Pleas hearings are not audio-recorded (“we don't record voice-wise”), which is difficult to reconcile both with the Court Reporter Section's correspondence and with the Portal's official record showing a digital court reporter assigned to that hearing. This unresolved uncertainty regarding the existence and custodian of the official record of the March 3, 2026 hearing itself frustrates meaningful appellate review, and I respectfully reserve that issue, which is raised in my filings. I will promptly forward to the Court any response received from the court reporter, including any statement that no transcript can be produced.

I am a Hebrew-speaking appellant with limited English proficiency, proceeding pro se. I respectfully ask that the Court accept this submission as timely compliance with its July 2, 2026 letter. If anything further is required of me in connection with the transcript, I respectfully ask to be advised in writing and I will comply immediately.

Dear Court Reporter Section,

Thank you for your response.

I understand your position that, under Rule 607, the written transcript is treated as the official record and that your office does not release audio or video recordings of proceedings.

However, I would like to note that in the Magistrate Court matter arising from the same underlying case, I was provided with the audio recording of the October 16, 2025 proceeding without difficulty. That recording was obtained through the same courthouse location in York County. For that reason, the different treatment of the March 3, 2026 hearing record is difficult to understand.

I also respectfully note that the underlying audio record is especially important where there may be disputes concerning the completeness, accuracy, or context of what occurred during the hearing. A transcript, by its nature, is a secondary representation of the proceeding. The original audio is the only record that preserves tone, interruptions, timing, and everything actually said in the courtroom.

If the Court's position is that the recording cannot be released, then I respectfully request the following in writing:

1. Confirmation that an audio recording of the March 3, 2026 hearing does in fact exist;
2. Identification of the office or custodian maintaining that recording;
3. The specific rule, statute, or administrative policy that prohibits release of that recording;
4. Confirmation that the recording is being preserved in full and has not been altered, overwritten, or deleted.

I fully intend to continue pursuing access to the complete record through all available lawful procedures. If release is not permitted directly, then the issue will ultimately have to be addressed through the appropriate judicial channels. For that reason, I ask that this email be treated as a formal request for confirmation and preservation of the underlying audio record.
