**APPELLANTS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO CURE FILING-FEE
DEFICIENCY**

Pursuant to Rules 240 and 263(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), Appellants Christopher Jones and Jane Freeman, appearing pro se, respectfully move this Court for a brief extension of three (3) days of the deadline to cure the deficiency identified in the Clerk's letter dated June 29, 2026, and in support thereof state as follows:

1. On June 29, 2026, the Clerk of this Court issued a deficiency letter regarding Appellants' petition for rehearing, noting that the required filing fee of \$50.00 had not been submitted, and directing that the deficiency be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of the letter.

2. Ten days from the date of the Clerk's letter falls on Thursday, July 9, 2026.

3. Appellants request a brief extension of three (3) days in which to remit the \$50.00 filing fee. Because the third day of the requested extension falls on Sunday, July 12, 2026, Appellants respectfully request that the deadline be extended through and including Monday, July 13, 2026, consistent with the computation of time under Rule 263(a), SCACR.

4. Good cause exists for this short extension. Appellants require the additional time to arrange for transmittal of the filing fee to the Clerk's office.

5. This motion is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay. The requested extension is minimal, and no party will be prejudiced by the brief enlargement of time sought. The petition for rehearing itself has already been filed; only the fee remains outstanding.

6. This is Appellants' first request for an extension of this deadline.

WHEREFORE, Appellants respectfully request that this Court grant an extension of three (3) days, through and including Monday, July 13, 2026, within which to submit the \$50.00 filing fee and cure the deficiency identified in the Clerk's June 29, 2026 letter, and grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
