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Good morning,

My name is Emily Hansbarger. I represent the Respondent in the above referenced matter. On June 29, 2026, the Court of Appeals sent a letter to both me and Appellant regarding a deficiency in the Proof of Service. I am attaching the letter for your reference. In the letter, it states that Appellant must correct any deficiency within 10 days of the date of the letter. The deficiency was the proof of service not being in compliance with SCACR that would provide address for myself as Respondent's counsel.

Appellant has failed to correct the deficiency. Given Appellant is a party to the action and a licensed, South Carolina attorney, I pray that the above referenced matter be dismissed with prejudice under SCACR 260. Appellant is a licensed South Carolina attorney and is/should be aware of the rules when filing an appeal. Appellant should be held to the same standard as any other South Carolina attorney.

Therefore, I pray the Court of Appeals dismisses the above referenced matter with prejudice and does not allow Appellant any additional time to correct the deficiency. Additionally, I pray the Court of Appeals award sanctions against Appellant as a result of the frivolous appeal pursuant to SCACR 269.
