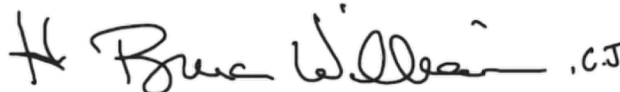

ORDER

This appeal arises out of an eviction action in magistrate court. Appeals from the magistrate court are properly filed in the court of common pleas, and not directly with this Court, as set forth by sections 18-7-10 (2017) and 27-37-120 (2017) of the South Carolina Code.
