**APPELLANTS' NOTICE REGARDING AMENDED MOTION FOR 60-DAY
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF**

Appellants E.B., a minor, E.R., a minor, S.S., individually and on behalf of E.B., C.B.,
individually and on behalf of E.B., and K.M., individually and on behalf of E.R. ("Appellants"),
by and through undersigned counsel, have moved the Court for a 60-day extension of time, up to
and including July 30, 2026, to file Appellants' Opening Brief and Designation of Matter.
Appellants' amended motion for extension of time is still pending.

In connection with their amended motion for extension of time, Appellants provide notice
of the following:

1. The order on appeal—the April 3, 2026 order granting Respondents' motion to
dismiss Appellants' Third Amended Complaint—was decided on the parties' written submissions;

no hearing was held on that motion. At the time Appellants filed their motion for extension of time and amended motion for extension of time, no transcript had been prepared or ordered in connection with this appeal.

2. The only reported substantive proceeding in the underlying action of which counsel is aware is an April 15, 2025 hearing on Respondents' earlier motion to dismiss, which resulted in the June 13, 2025 written order that granted the motion to dismiss without prejudice. In an abundance of caution, and to ensure the completeness of the record, on July 7, 2026, Appellants requested a transcript of the April 15, 2025 hearing through the Office of Court Administration's transcript request system, with expedited seven-day delivery. A copy of the transcript request correspondence is attached as Exhibit A.

3. Although the April 15, 2025 hearing transcript has been requested, Appellants respectfully submit that no hearing transcript is required for appellate review in this case because the appeal is from a written order entered without a hearing on the motion at issue. *See Woodson v. DLI Props., LLC*, 406 S.C. 517, 526–28, 753 S.E.2d 428, 433–34 (2014) (explaining that “what the circuit court ‘might’ have stated during the hearing on the motion for summary judgment is irrelevant, as a written order constitutes a final order and final judgment of the lower court” and holding the record sufficient for appellate review without the hearing transcript).

4. Appellants do not seek any modification of their pending amended motion for extension of time on account of the transcript request. Subject to the Court's approval, Appellants will serve and file their Opening Brief and Designation of Matter on or before July 30, 2026, the original date requested.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons provided in their amended motion for extension of time and this notice, Appellants respectfully request that the Court grant a 60-day extension of time, up

to and including July 30, 2026, for filing the Appellants' Opening Brief and Designation of Matter, and grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
