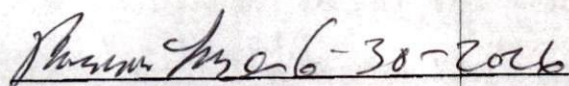
Therefore, your grievance is upheld.

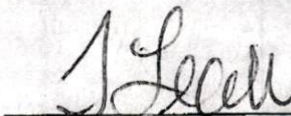

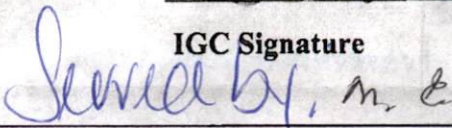
