Upon reviewing your client's notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal Form 1 states that a July 7, 2026, order is being appealed and the email correspondence states that a June 17, 2026, order is being appealed. You must provide an amended notice of appeal that reflects which order will be appealed.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- You must provide proof of filing the notice of appeal with the Berkeley County Clerk of Court.
