Dear Mr. Reeves:

Upon reviewing your attempted deficiency corrections for your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide a proof of service that shows service upon The State.
- Your proof of service states that you have sent a copy of the notice of appeal to the trial court judge. You must provide proof of filing a copy of your notice of appeal with the Greenville County Clerk of Court, not the judge.
- The notice of appeal must include the date that you received the order under appeal.
- The argument provided in your notice of appeal cannot be considered at this time. You must serve and file a notice of appeal that is substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to Part II of the SCACR.
