COMES NOW, attorney Lawrence C. Kobrovsky, representing the Appellant, Michelle L. Robinson in this matter and respectfully requests permission pursuant to Rule 207, SCACR, to order the transcripts outside of the filing deadline set by Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

In support of the Motion, Appellant acting by and through her counsel respectfully states as follows:

1. I am the attorney of record for the Appellant, Michelle L. Robinson in this matter.
2. On July 9, 2026 I received notice from the South Carolina Court of Appeals that the time for ordering the transcript has expired.

3. Today is July 10, 2026, one day after receipt of the notice that the time has expired for ordering the transcript.
4. I acknowledge the time has expired and I respectfully request permission to order the transcript outside of the following deadline on the following bases. I recently had a total hip replacement on March 24, 2026 and have had complicated recovery. In addition to several weeks of insomnia, including a week in which I don't remember sleeping at all, I developed an infection at the site of the incision which occurred as I finally got over the insomnia. I have only recently returned to work after several months of at home bed rest. The lack of sleep has affected some of my short term memory and attention to detail, hopefully temporarily. I am also suffering from mobility issues I never experienced before. In good faith, I had mistakenly thought I had ordered the Transcript for the Appellate Panel Hearing of 2-9-2026. My mistake was I had ordered and paid for the transcript of the Commission Hearing held on July 7, 2025. On July 1, 2026, I paid for the "Transcript of Hearing" in Michelle Robinson vs. Charleston County School District. Please find attached as **Exhibit A** my payment of that "Transcript". My mistake was that this was the "Transcript of Hearing" for the Hearing Commissioner of July 7, 2025 and not the Appellant Panel of February 9, 2026. I did request today, July 10, 20026 the transcript of February 9, 2026 of the Appellate Panel Hearing in the event my Motion is granted. Please find also my request for that Transcript dated today, July 10, 2026 as **Exhibit B**. I requested this transcript to be expedited, to be received by next Friday, in order to lessen any prejudice to the Respondent, in the event my Request for Permission is granted.
5. I am sending the \$50.00 filing fee made out to the SC Court of Appeals by separate cover letter, also mailed today, July 10, 2026. A copy of the \$50.00 check and cover letter is attached as my **Exhibit C**.
6. In good faith, the delivery will not cause unfair harm or material prejudice to the Respondents ability to defend the Appeal. As the attorney for the Appellant, I have made this Motion within a day of receiving the Notice of the time expiring, and have requested the Transcript this same date by expedited manner to minimize any prejudice to the Respondent.

7. The Court Reporter has already acknowledged my request for the expedited transcript and has already been place in line for transcription. I have attached as **Exhibit D.**, the acknowledgement of the Court Report, Cheryle Wiszowaty at 3:18pm, today, July 10, 2026.
8. I have in good faith tried to remedy this manner and minimize any prejudice to the Respondent.
9. The legal authority for this Request to extend the time to request the Transcript is in Rule 263 (b) of the SCACR which specifically states that “the time prescribed b these Rules for performing any act except the time for serving the Notice of Appeal under Rules 203 and 243 may be extended by Appellate Court, or by any Judge or Justice. It is acknowledged that pursuant to Rule 207(b) the deadline for ordering the Transcript was missed and it is now respectfully requested that for good cause, excusable negligence and in the interest of justice, as shown above that the Court exercise it’s discretion and grant this request for permission for an extension of time to request the transcript

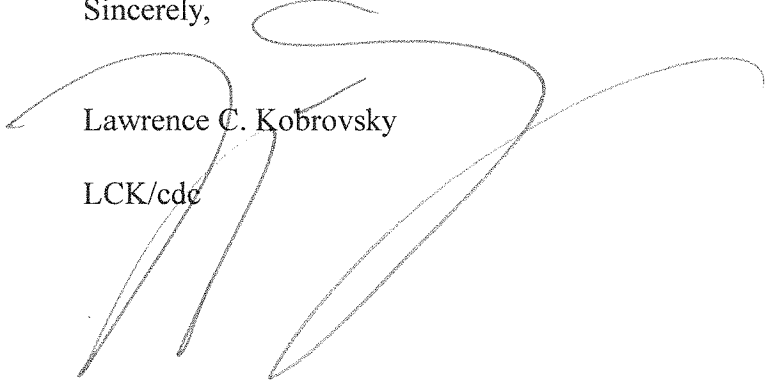

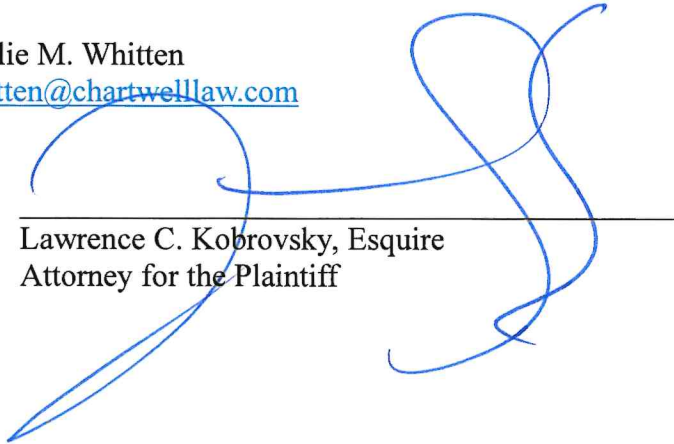
