**EMERGENCY MOTION TO STAY**

Comes now the Appellant, Attia Elbadawy, Pro Se, and respectfully moves this Honorable Court for an Order staying enforcement of the **May 26,2026 Order** denying Appellant's Motion for Injunctive Relief against Respondent **Dorchester County**, pending disposition of this appeal.

**BACKGROUND**

1. On May 7, 2026, Judge Diane S. Goodstein entered an Order denying injunctive relief against D.R. Horton, Inc.
2. The Appellant repeatedly attempted to obtain the proposed order before entry, but neither Respondent, D R Horton, Inc. nor the lower court provide or placed it on the public docket.
3. On May 22, 2026, the Appellant filed a Notice of Appeal from the May 7,2026 Order.
4. On May 26, 2026, Judge Goodstein entered a separate Order denying injunctive relief concerning Respondent, Dorchester County.
5. The Appellant sought clarification, but the lower court never explained the purpose of the second Order.
6. On June 16, 2026, the Appellant filed a Notice of Appeal from the May 26,2026 Order together with a Motion to Stay.
7. On July 15, 2026, this Court denied the Motion to Stay relating to the May 7,2026 Order.
8. The Court did not rule on the separate Motion to Stay directed to the May 26,2026 Order involving Respondent, Dorchester County.
9. Accordingly, this Emergency Motion requests a stay of the May 26,2026 Order.
10. The Appellant also repeatedly requested the proposed May 26, Order from Respondent, Dorchester County but received no response and no proposed order was posted before entry.

## CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

### ARGUMENT

11. The May 26, 2026 Order is separate from the May 7, 2026 Order and requires separate consideration.
12. The Court's July 15, 2026 ruling addressed only the May 7 Order and not the May 26 Order.
13. The May 26 Order was separately appealed on June 16, 2026, and the requested stay remains unresolved.
14. Enforcement of that Order during the appeal may result in irreparable harm.
15. A stay preserves the status quo while the appeal is pending.
16. This Motion seeks a ruling only on the May 26, 2026 Order, not reconsideration of the Court's July 15, 2026 Order.

### WHEREFORE

The Appellant respectfully requests that this Court grant this Emergency Motion to Stay, Stay Enforcement

of the May 26, 2026 Order pending appeal, preserve the status quo, and grant such other relief as the Court deems just and proper.
