INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on JUL 12 2024 the
Grand Jurors of Spartanburg County present upon their oath:

ASSAULT AND BATTERY OF A HIGH AND AGGRAVATED NATURE

That the Defendant Daquan Markeise Terrell did in Spartanburg County on or about April 5, 2024 commit an assault and battery upon the victim, [REDACTED] unlawfully injuring the victim and great bodily injury to the victim to the victim resulted or the act was accomplished by means likely to produce death or great bodily injury to wit: grabbing the victim, pushing the victim, pointing a firearm at the victim, and/or by threatening to shoot and/or kill her, in violation of §16-3-600(B)(1), *THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA*, (1976), as amended.

COUNT TWO- POSSESSION OF WEAPON DURING VIOLENT CRIME

That Daquan Markeise Terrell did in Spartanburg County on or about April 5, 2024, possess a firearm, or visibly display what appeared to be a firearm, or visibly display a firearm during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime to wit: ASSAULT AND BATTERY OF A HIGH AND AGGRAVATED NATURE, in violation of §16-23-490, *CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA*, (1976) as amended.
