ORDER OF DAMAGES

THIS MATTER comes before me following an Entry of Default against Defendant Saronta Foneak Campbell. Pursuant to Rule 53 of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure, a damages hearing was held on May 27, 2026, at 10:00 A.M. Present at the hearing was counsel for Plaintiff, William H. Yarborough, the Plaintiff, and Defendant Saronta Foneak Campbell.

Evidence was presented at the hearing on behalf of the Plaintiff. The Plaintiff testified regarding their injuries, medical bills, and how the accident had affected themselves both physically and emotionally. Plaintiff Allison Wingate testified that she was injured in the incident and went to the emergency room for treatment. She suffered injuries, specifically bite marks, to both of her legs. Plaintiff Allison Wingate testified that she has incurred \$ 22, 021.46 in medical bills to date and that she still suffered from lingering pain in both of her legs. Plaintiff testified that she has been continuing to treat and would need to continue seeking treatment as a result of the incident.

After considering the evidence presented, I FIND:

- A) That an Entry of Default was properly entered against Defendant ;
- B) Plaintiff provided reasonable notice of the hearing on damages in accordance with the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure;

- C) Defendant has defaulted thus admitting all allegations against them, including, but not limited to, allegations that they failed to maintain control of their animals and failed to properly train their animals causing this incident;
- D) Plaintiff was injured and in the incident as set forth in the Complaint filed in this action;
- E) Plaintiff Allison Wingate has incurred past medical expenses in the amount of \$22,021.46 due to the incident;
- F) Plaintiff Allison Wingate has suffered and continues to suffer from injuries sustained in this incident;
- G) Plaintiff Allison Wingate will have to continue to have medical care and treatment as a result of the incident;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that judgment is entered in favor of:

- Plaintiff Allison Wingate against Defendant in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand and 00/100 (\$150,000.00) inclusive of all consequential, actual, punitive, and property damages.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
