Application to proceed in Forma Pauperis for the pre-payment of fees and costs associated with filing in the above matter is hereby submitted in that the Appellant in this cause is a person who is currently unemployed and incarcerated but challenges said issues on appeal which are alleged constitutional in nature,

That the appellant is insolvent and poor and unable to pay for the costs of filing, but believes he is entitled to relief on appeal by right under the Constitution to which he has a vested Liberty interest.

The appellant further submits that he can have his inmate account debited in the future against any monies that he may receive to be deducted thereupon and provided to the court of appeals, or that a Civil Judgment may be made against him to enforce the payment of said filing fee in accordance with the laws regarding "Civil Liens".
