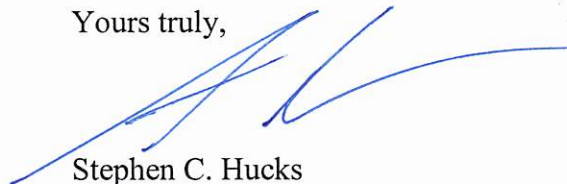
Dear Clerk,

THIS MATTER COMES BEFORE THE COURT upon the request of attorney Katherine Gettys ("Ms. Gettys") to be relieved of her duties as Personal Representative with Restrictions in the Estate of McGee Still.

Ms. Gettys was appointed as Personal Representative of the Estate of McGee Still ("Estate") on May 12, 2026, as a neutral third party for the limited purpose of undertaking immediate action pursuant to this Court's specific authority. Ms. Gettys' appointment was restricted to the completion of five (5) enumerated tasks.

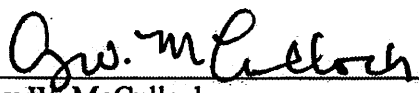
The Court held a virtual status conference on June 3, 2026, during which Ms. Gettys reported that all five (5) tasks set forth in the Court's May 12, 2026, Order. However, Ms. Gettys requested that the Court amend Paragraph five (5) of its May 12, 2026, Order to authorize and direct her to distribute any Adult Protective Services ("APS") reports to all attorneys involved in the Estate of McGee Still or the Matter of Sara Margaret Still, and the Guardian ad Litem.

The Court informed Ms. Gettys that, upon distribution of the APS reports, she would be relieved of her appointment as Personal Representative with Restrictions. Ms. Gettys has since distributed the APS reports in accordance with this Court's direction.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Katherine Gettys is relieved as Personal Representative of the Estate of McGee Still. Accordingly, Katherine Gettys shall file a fee affidavit with the Court within twenty (20) days of the date of this Order.
