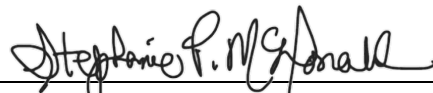
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## ORDER

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On June 16, 2026, Respondents filed a motion for an extension of time for the parties to serve and file their final briefs, explaining a motion to supplement the record was forthcoming. On June 22, 2026, Respondents filed a motion to supplement the record on appeal. On June 29, 2026, Appellant filed a return to both motions, taking no formal position on Respondents' motions, asking for specific dates for filing deadlines, and requesting Respondents be responsible for additional expenses associated with the supplemental record on appeal should this court grant Appellant's motion. After careful consideration, we grant Respondents' motions.

Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall file the record on appeal and Respondents shall serve and file the supplemental record on appeal. Once both portions of the record have been filed with this court, the parties shall serve and file their final briefs within twenty days of the filing that completes the record on appeal. Respondents shall be responsible for the costs associated with the serving and filing of the supplemental record on appeal, including any copies requested by this court.
