I am writing to request immediate assistance locating and providing the order signed by Judge Hayes in my Common Pleas appeal, Case No. 2026-CP-42-01706 (Sylecia McIntyre v. State of South Carolina).

Hearing date: July 12, 2026 (motion to alter/amend judgment).

Order date: Judge Hayes stated on the record that he would "take the matter under advisement" and, according to the bench, signed the final disposition order on July 15, 2026 dismissing my appeal.

Subsequent events:

On July 17, 2026 I received a Summary Court Summons to appear in Magistrate Court on July 20, 2026.

At that July 20 hearing, Judge Wood displayed the signed disposition order from Judge Hayes.

Current problem:

Your counter staff and the online judicial index both show no entry of this July 15 order.

Without the disposition I cannot file further motions or my Rule 242 writ of certiorari.

Request:

Please conduct an expedited search of the physical and electronic records for the July 15, 2026 order entered by Judge Hayes in Case No. 2026-CP-42-01706.

If the order truly has not been entered, please confirm that fact in writing so I can address the omission with the court.

I, **Sylecia McIntyre**, being of lawful age and competent to testify to the facts herein, declare under penalty of perjury that the following statements are true and correct:

1. On 21 July 2026, I placed a telephone call to the Spartanburg County Clerk of Court's office. The call began at approximately 9:04 a.m. and concluded at approximately 9:23 a.m.
2. During that call I spoke with a deputy clerk who identified herself as "Shay," spelled S-H-A-E. I asked Shay whether an order signed by Judge Hayes on 15 July 2026 in Case No. 2026-CP-42-01706 had been filed and entered in the docket. Shay stated there was no such order entered.
3. At approximately 10:00 a.m. the same morning, I made a second call to the Clerk's office and spoke with another deputy clerk who identified herself as "Mary Bell." I again inquired about the alleged 15 July 2026 order, explaining that the document was urgently needed to preserve my appellate rights. Mary Bell confirmed that no order had been filed or entered since 19 June 2026.
4. I further explained to Mary Bell that Judge Wood had shown me a disposition order during a Summary Court hearing on 20 July 2026, stating that Judge Hayes had dismissed my appeal, and that the dismissal was the basis for the summons directing me to appear on that date. Despite this, both deputy clerks stated the dismissal order could not be located in the judicial index or in their internal records.
5. On 21 July 2026 I e-mailed Ms. Amy Cox, Clerk of Court for Spartanburg County, requesting an immediate copy of the 15 July 2026 order. As of the execution of this affidavit, no response has been received. A true copy of my e-mail to Ms. Cox is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.

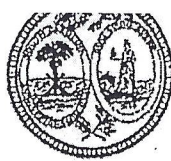

If you do not surrender your vehicle tag, it will be confiscated by a law enforcement officer and additional penalties and fines may also apply.

Failure to respond to this notice before the suspension date listed above will result in the suspension of your vehicle registration and drivers license. If there has been a lapse in your insurance coverage, you will be charged a penalty of \$5.00 per day for each uninsured day from 01/12/2026, up to a maximum of \$200.00. 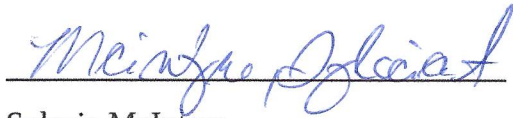

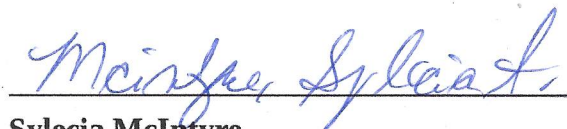
