Narratives

Department Fire Incident Narrative

On 11 June 2026 Westview Engine 32 responded to the above address for a Smoke Odor Inside.

Upon arrival, E32 Crew were met by the caller in her apartment. Per the caller, maintenance had been out earlier to fix a pipe in the apartment above hers. Now the pipe was leaking onto her hot water heater.

A/O Cooke located the hot water heater in a bedroom closet. There was a piece of particle board that had already bent over under its own weight due to the water damage it had sustained. There was a steady trickle of water coming from the ceiling above the water heater and falling onto the heater.

A/O Cooke secured the breaker to the hot water heater and locked out the breaker.

Dispatch was requested to call the site maintenance personnel to respond out; site maintenance stated that they would not come out unless the unit was flooded or if there was a fire. A/O Cooke then requested for Spartanburg County Environmental Enforcement to respond out.

E32 Crew then went to apartment 202 to see if there was still water leaking from that unit. Upon discussing the situation with the tenant in 202, E32 Crew located the hot water heater and A/C condensation line. The condensation line was clogged up and water was actively leaking from it.

E32 operated on scene until the arrival of SCEE and site maintenance. Maintenance personnel were instructed to leave the breaker locked out until a licensed hot water heater technician could come out and inspect the heater.

After ensuring no further assistance was required, E32 went call complete.
