Ms. Todd:

While you acknowledged the transcript request on 6/1 (below), my original request was on 5/18 and I believe that 5/18 date is the one the appellate court rules run the 60 day timer off. Per rule 207, it appears to me that you're required to request an extension from the court or, if you don't, I have to alert the court 10 days after the 60 day deadline. I don't believe that the date of the request would be included in the calculation, so I believe the deadline hit over the weekend, and thus falls on today.

If you have the transcript ready and simply haven't sent it, wonderful. If you need more time, please file for the extension with the court [per SC Rule of Appellate Procedure 207(a)(3)]. If you don't request the extension Rule 207(a)(5) requires me, after 10 days from today, so presumably on July 30th, to "notify the Office of Court Administration, the clerk of the appellate court, and the court reporter in writing."
