On July 24, 2026, we filed on behalf of Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP or the Company) a notice of appeal from the Public Service Commission of South Carolina's (the Commission) July 15, 2026 order. We also filed, in the alternative, a petition for the Court to issue a common-law writ of certiorari in its original jurisdiction, a notice of petition, an appendix with the pertinent filings below, and a certificate of service.

Although the notice of appeal references an exhibit, DEP intended to reference the copy of the July 15 order located on pages 1–17 of the appendix in the July 24 filing package. *See* Rule 203(d)(2)(B)(ii), SCACR (requiring an appellant provide “[a] copy of the decision(s) to be challenged on appeal”). Because the Court has created separate cases for the notice of appeal and petition for a common-law writ of certiorari in its original jurisdiction in C-Track, the order does not appear in Case No. 2026-001613. Thus, attached is a copy of the July 15 order—which was submitted with the July 24 filing and is in Case No. 2026-001614—to help clarify the record.
