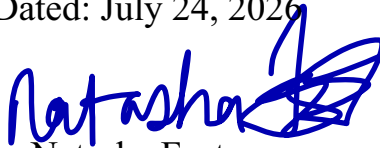
MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION AND REQUEST FOR
INSTRUCTIONS TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT: I,
Natasha Foster appearing pro se (representing myself), respectfully request
clarification and specific procedural instructions regarding the Court's recent

Order on my Motion to Stay. In support of this request, I state the
following: On or about July 21, 2026 this Court issued an Order addressing
my Motion to Stay. Per the terms of that Order, I am required to submit an
affidavit to proceed with the next steps of my case and maintain the stay. The

Order itself does not contain the specific instructions, formatting
requirements, or guidelines on how to execute, format, or submit this
required affidavit. I have made diligent, good-faith efforts to obtain these
instructions. I have contacted both the lower courts and the clerk of this
Court. To date, neither court has been able to provide me with the specific
instructions or forms needed to comply with the Order. Because time may be
of the essence to protect my housing and legal rights, I am at a standstill
without this crucial information. WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that
this Court issue clear instructions or a supplemental directive detailing: Who
the affidavit must be submitted to (e.g., the Clerk of Court, a specific judge,
or the lower court); How it must be submitted (e.g., e-filing, in-person filing,
or certified mail); and Any specific content or forms required for the affidavit
to be deemed legally sufficient under the Order.
