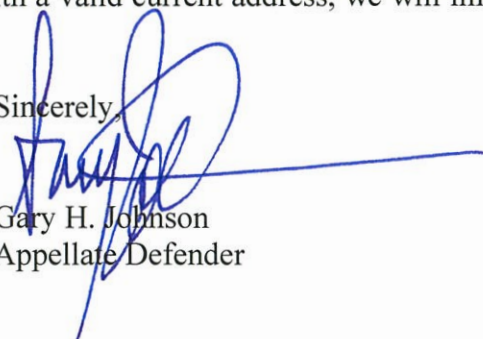

Dear Ms. Kitchings:

Unfortunately, to date this office has been unable to contact Ms. Lurry. The 417 NW 4th Ave. address in Boynton Beach, Florida, was the last known address generated during our searches (which we updated today in response to the Court's inquiry) and was the address Ms. Lurry reported during her lower court appearances. Ms. Lurry had previously lived at the address of 925 Avenue S., West Palm Beach, Florida 33404. Correspondences sent to that address have been returned by the Post Office as undeliverable with no forwarding address. Attempts at communication were also sent to an address in Georgia since she spent some time in that state prior to her trial and since her trial date. That address was 1465 Mid Broadwell Road, Apt. 2110 in Alpharetta, GA 30004. The cellular phone number provided by our search is no longer in service. At this time, all mailings to Ms. Lurry have either been returned as undelivered or have generated no response from Ms. Lurry.

Based upon our efforts to contact Ms. Lurry, it is believed she has most recently resided at the Boynton Beach address with sporadic stays in the area of Alpharetta, Georgia. We have sent additional contact letters to addresses of known connection to Ms. Lurry in an attempt to establish contact. If we receive a response with a valid current address, we will inform the Court immediately.
