Dear Ms. Kitchings:

In my last correspondence I informed the Court of Appeals that the circuit court had issued an order staying enforcement of the injunction that is at issue in this appeal. The circuit court set bond at \$10,000.00. I contacted the Richland County Clerk of Court to make arrangements for payment of that amount into Court, but the Clerk stated that she could not accept the funds because the order did not direct her to do so.

I have been in contact with counsel for Respondents to discuss securing the bond amount. At this time, the Appellants have deposited with my law firm's trust account the full \$10,000.00 bond amount. My law firm will continue to hold this amount in trust until the conclusion of this appeal. Counsel for Respondents has not objected to this method of handling the bond amount. Please let me know if this is satisfactory to the Court of Appeals or if we need to make some other arrangement.
