## ORDER

---

Respondents have filed a motion to compel Appellant to order the transcript from the proceedings before the circuit court and stay the deadline to file and serve their initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. Alternatively, Respondents ask this Court to dismiss the appeal. Appellant filed a return, asking this Court to sanction Respondents. Respondents' motion to compel and to stay its filing deadlines is granted. *See* Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR (noting the appellant shall order the transcript from the proceedings below). Appellant will provide the Court and Respondents with documentation indicating he either ordered the transcript from the circuit court or none exists within thirty days of this order. Respondents will serve and file their initial brief and designation of matter within thirty days of receipt of the transcript. If Appellant fails to provide such documentation within thirty days, this Court will consider Respondents' motion to dismiss the appeal. Appellant's motion for sanctions is denied.
