The Court issued a Form 4 on April 14, 2026 granting Defendant Canterbury Park's Motion for Summary Judgment. A formal order was filed on May 6, 2026. In its ruling, the Court relied on the Motion, Memorandum in Support of its Motion, argument of counsel and various exhibits presented. Plaintiffs did not file a Memorandum in opposition. Plaintiffs initially filed a Motion to Reconsider based on the Form 4 issued April 14, 2026 and then filed a more formal Motion to Reconsider on May 27, 2026. Upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion to Reconsider, the Court does not find that the Plaintiffs have presented any grounds for altering or amending its May 6, 2026 Order and Plaintiffs' Motion is respectfully denied.
