MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Andrew Whetstone with the Court of Appeals on June 24, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. James Brown with the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals on June 15, 2026. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Zy'Tawn Childs v. State with the Supreme Court on June 15, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. David Stowers with the Court of Appeals on June 12, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Christian Scowcroft v. State with the Supreme Court on June 5, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. David Matthews with the Court of Appeals on May 29, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Jeremy Cornish with the Court of Appeals on May 28, 2026.

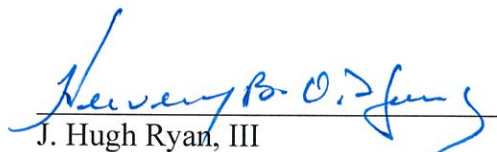

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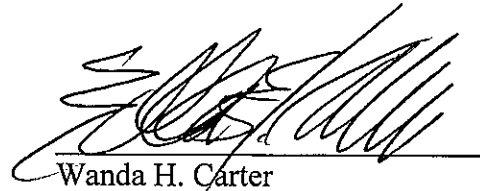
