**MOTION REGARDING DORCHESTER COUNTY'S
STATUS ON APPEAL AND SUPPLEMENT TO OBJECTION.**

**Comes now, the Appellants, Pro Se, Respectfully Supplement
their previously filed Objection and Motion concerning the
omission of the Respondent, Dorchester County as a Respondent
in the Court of Appeals ,CASE No: 2025-001299.**

BACKGROUND

**On July 20,2026 the Appellants filed a Motion for
Reconsideration to recognize Respondent, Dorchester
County as a part of the Appeal CASE N0: 2025-001299**

**On July 27,2026, the Appellants recieved an email from
the Court of Appeals Court Clerk :Jenny Abbott Kitchings
Stating the following:**

**Pursuant to Rule 221(c) of the South Carolina Appellate
Court Rules: This Court will not entertain a Motion to
Reconsider an Order of the Court unless the action of the
Court on the Motion has the effect of dismissing or
finally deciding a parties Appeal. Accordingly , no
further action will be taken on your Motion for
Reconsideration. See Email Exhibit-X.**

**The record reflects that Dorchester County was
brought into the circuit court proceedings as a Third
Party Defendant, appeared through counsel, participated
in hearings reflected in the transcript and received
service of the Notice of Appeal, together with proof of
service was accepted and file-stamped by the Court
of Appeals . Dorchester County was likewise served
with the Appellants Initial Brief and subesquent
appellate filings.**

Despite the foregoing, Appellants have been unable to locate any order removing Dorchester County from the appeal, dismissing the County as a party, or otherwise explaining its omission from the appellate caption and proceedings.

Accordingly, Appellants respectfully request that the Court identify:

1. The rule, statute, or other legal authority relied upon to omit Dorchester County as a respondent in this appeal;
2. The date of any order affecting Dorchester County's status;
3. The specific order, if one exists, removing or dismissing Dorchester County from the appeal;
4. The legal reasoning supporting that action; and
5. Whether the action was authorized by a judge or judicial panel of the Court.

In the absence of such an order, Appellants respectfully object to proceeding without clarification of Dorchester County's status.

Appellants submit that the appellate record should accurately reflect the status of all parties who appeared in the circuit court and whose participation is documented by the record and certificates of service.

Authorities for the Court's consideration include Rules 202, 203, 210, and 221, SCACR, together with any other rule or authority the Court believes governs the omission of a party who appeared below and was served with the Notice of Appeal and appellate filings. Appellants respectfully request that the Court identify the applicable authority so that the issue may be properly addressed and preserved for further review if necessary.

RELIEF REQUESTED

- 1) Recognize Respondent, Dorchester County on the Appeal.**
- 2) Compel Respondent, Dorchester County to Submit the Initial Brief.**
- 3) And for such relief as this Court deems proper.**
