Dear Petitioner:

Your counsel has submitted a petition for writ of certiorari pursuant to *Austin v. State*, and a petition for a writ of certiorari pursuant to *Johnson v. State*, indicating that this appeal is without legal merit sufficient to warrant a new trial and moves to be relieved as your counsel. *Austin v.
