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To the Honorable Court,

I am writing to express my deep disappointment and concern regarding the handling of my civil case involving Mr. Brockman. What should have been a straightforward matter has turned into a lengthy, expensive, and frustrating experience that has left me questioning whether our justice system is truly holding people accountable for their actions.

After returning from a deployment with the United States Army, I had one goal: to have my grandfather's car rebuilt. The vehicle is more than just a car—it is a family heirloom that was passed down to me after my grandfather passed away. To make the process easier, I hired a transportation company. Unfortunately, that decision resulted in one of the most difficult experiences I have ever faced.

Throughout this case, I provided my attorney with extensive evidence, including screenshots of text messages and other documentation that were presented to the Court. There are also numerous public complaints and videos documenting similar experiences involving Mr. Brockman and his company, showing that I am far from the only person who has been affected.

Mr. Brockman repeatedly failed to appear in court. On multiple occasions, the Court instructed his attorney that my vehicle was to be returned to me. Despite those orders, I was informed that Mr. Brockman simply refused to comply. As someone who respects the law, it was extremely discouraging to witness a court order seemingly ignored without meaningful consequences.

On the one occasion Mr. Brockman did appear in court, he argued with the Judge in a disrespectful manner. Yet despite his behavior and refusal to comply with the Court's directives, I remain without my vehicle and have been forced to absorb enormous financial losses.

When this case began, I was not seeking damages. I simply wanted my car returned. However, as the case dragged on, I incurred substantial attorney's fees—approximately \$20,000—far exceeding what it would have cost to rebuild the vehicle in the first place. In addition, my vehicle has suffered damages while being wrongfully withheld.

I have proudly served this country for eighteen years in the United States Army and am currently working toward my twentieth year of service. I also maintain a civilian

career with Duke Energy, own two successful businesses, coach youth sports, and strive to live my life according to Christian values. I believe in respecting the law and doing things the right way. That is why this experience has been so disheartening.

It is difficult to understand how someone can openly disregard the Court's orders and continue causing financial harm to others without being held accountable. If court orders can simply be ignored, it undermines public confidence in the justice system and sends the wrong message to honest, law-abiding citizens.

Because of everything that has occurred, I respectfully request that the Court consider awarding compensation for my attorney's fees, the damages to my vehicle, and the financial losses I have suffered as a direct result of Mr. Brockman's refusal to comply with the Court's orders. I did not initially seek any monetary compensation—I only wanted my vehicle returned. Unfortunately, the ongoing delays and continued noncompliance have made that impossible.

Thank you for your time and consideration. I respectfully ask that justice be served and that this matter be resolved in a way that holds Mr. Brockman accountable for his actions.
