Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Mark Anthony Festus Scheibler with the Court of Appeals on June 11, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Brian N. White v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 5, 2026. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. John Wilson Williamson, III, et al. before the Court of Appeals on June 2, 2026.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

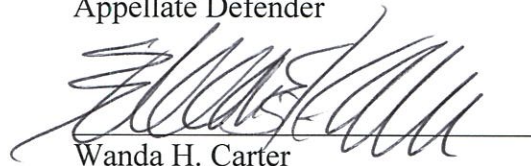
