ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 222 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the motion for costs filed by Appellants Chris Thompson Services and Bridgefield Casualty Insurance is granted in the amount of \$3,763.97 against Respondent South Carolina Uninsured Employers' Fund. The lower court or tribunal is directed to add this award of costs to the remittitur.

The court declines to award \$346,451.24 in requested costs for reimbursement of workers' compensation benefits paid during the pendency of this action, as well as the requested reimbursement of the \$150 filing fee paid to the Workers' Compensation Commission, as those costs are not authorized by Rule 222.
