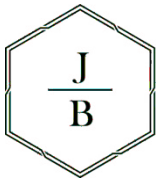

I represent Petitioner Jevon Carter in the above matter. We would respectfully request an extension of 15 days for Mr. Carter to file his Reply to The State of South Carolina's Response to Petition for a Writ of Certiorari, filed on August 3, 2026.
