Dear Mr. Bruce:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service provided states that the “petition for writ of certiorari” was served on the respondent’s counsel and not your notice of appeal. You must provide a proof of service showing you served the respondent’s counsel with a copy of your notice of appeal.
- Proof of filing with the clerk of the lower court has not been provided pursuant to Rule 203(d), SCACR.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. **The correct filing fee is \$250.00.**
- The notice of appeal is not in the proper format. You must file an amended notice of appeal that does not contain any argument. Your notice of appeal must be substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to Part II of the SCACR.
