ORDER

This appeal arises out of the circuit court's order striking Appellant's answer and counterclaims. On June 9, 2026, this Court issued an order denying Respondent's second motion to dismiss and requiring Appellant to provide proof of service for the record on appeal within 20 days of the date of the order or the appeal would be dismissed. To date, Appellant has not provided proof of service for the record on appeal, but he has filed a motion seeking clarification. Appellant also requests we consider his motion for clarification without payment of the motion filing fee.

After careful consideration, the motion for clarification is granted as follows: Appellant must provide proof of service for the record on appeal, including proof that he has prepared the record on appeal as provided by Rules 210 and 267, SCACR, and mailed a copy of the full record to Respondent's counsel. In his motion, Appellant indicates he has served Respondent and this Court with the record on appeal on June 16, 2024. However, as set forth by Rule 210(c), SCACR, the record on appeal must include all matters designated for inclusion by all parties. Appellant is responsible for preparation and service of the record on appeal. The court reporter is not responsible for service of the record on appeal. In this limited circumstance we will consider Appellant's motion for clarification without payment of the motion filing fee. However, this order does not reconsider or rehear Judge Vinson's June 9, 2026 order. *See* Rule 221(c), SCACR ("The appellate court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal.")

If Appellant has not provided proof of service of the record on appeal as set forth above within 10 days of the date of this order, this appeal will be dismissed.
