**MOTION FOR 60-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF ON BEHALF OF
RESPONDENTS UBER TECHNOLOGIES, INC., AND RASIER LLC**

Respondents Uber Technologies, Inc., and Rasier LLC, by and through undersigned
counsel, respectfully move the Court for a 60-day extension of time to file the Initial Brief on
behalf of Respondents Uber Technologies, Inc., and Rasier LLC (“These Respondents”).

This motion is made pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Court Rules 263 and 240. Rule
263 authorizes this Court, or any judge or justice thereof, to extend the time to perform any act
short of serving the notice of appeal. Rule 240 governs motions for such an extension of time.

In support of the requested relief, Respondents state the following:

1. These Respondents were served with Appellants’ Initial Brief and Designation of
Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal via electronic mail on July 30, 2026.

2. Pursuant to Rule 208 and Rule 263 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the Initial Brief from These Respondents is due on August 31, 2026, as thirty days after July 30, 2026, falls on a Saturday and thirty-one days falls on a Sunday.

3. These Respondents seek a 60-day extension up to and including October 30, 2026, to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal.

4. Appellant's Initial Brief was originally due on May 31, 2026. However, counsel for Appellants requested a 60-day extension. Counsel for These Respondents consented to, and this Court granted, the extension.

5. Included with Appellants' Motion for Extension of Time was a reference to Appellants' consent to an expected similar request for an extension of time to be filed on behalf of These Respondents. *See* Appellants' Mot. for Extension of Time at 2, ¶ 7.

6. Counsel for Appellants consented to this 60-day extension via email on May 5, 2026.

7. This is the first request on behalf of These Respondents for an extension of the Initial Brief deadline.

8. The requested extension will not prejudice Appellants and is sought in good faith to ensure the issues are fully and properly presented for the Court's consideration.

WHEREFORE, These Respondents respectfully request that the Court grant a 60-day extension of time, up to and including September 28, 2026, for filing the Respondents' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal.

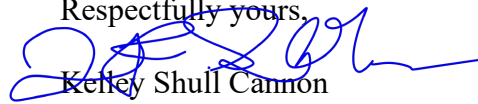
