MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Anthony Donnell Brown respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from August 12, 2026, until September 11, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Anthony Donnell Brown respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

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number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel will file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Eric Neal Patton v. The State with the Supreme Court today. Counsel spoke at and attended a CLE on August 6-7, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Breonte A. Glasgow with the Court of Appeals on July 31, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Stacy Michelle Rabon with the Court of Appeals on July 30, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. James Etheridge Jones with the Court of Appeals on July 28, 2026. Counsel filed the Motion to Hold Appeal in Abeyance and Remand for Reconstruction of the Record in the case of Michael Myers v. SCDMH with the Supreme Court on July 1, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Ryan Woodruff with the Court of Appeals on June 29, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant, Motion to Supplement the Record on Appeal, and Supplemental Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Kenneth Dawson with the Court of Appeals on June 16, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Sinatra L. Hunter v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 15, 2026.

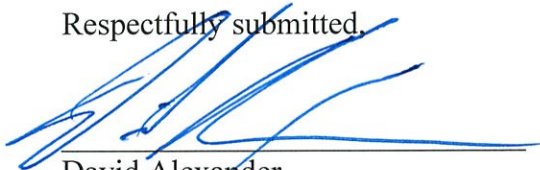
4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

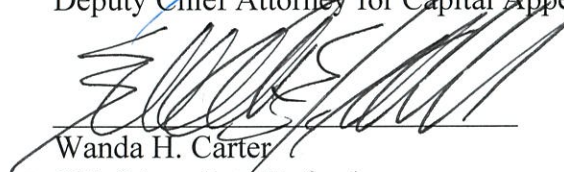
5. On August 3, 2026, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy

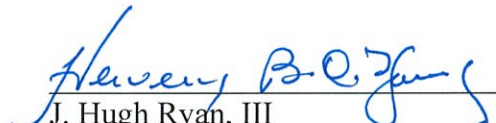
Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through September 1, 2026.
